# Dental Desensitizing / Remineralizing Agent

## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

ReminGel is a convenient, premixed, ready-to-use, opaque aqueous-based gel. ReminGel consists of suspended hydroxyapatite and calcium and phosphate salts that help restore a tooth's hydroxyapatite structure through remineralization.

This remineralization results in tubule occlusion and blocks fluid flow in dentinal tubules, thereby relieving dentinal sensitivity. Additionally, ReminGel blocks nerve excitability through potassium release.

## INDICATIONS FOR USE:

 To relieve dental hypersensitivity caused by bleaching procedures, cold, heat, acids, or sweets.

#### INTENDED USERS:

- Dental professionals may prescribe ReminGel to patients for their use.
- Patients may directly purchase ReminGel for use.

#### **CONTRAINDICATIONS:**

 Do not use ReminGel in patients with a known allergy to any of the product's ingredients.
 An allergic reaction may require treatment.

#### PRECAUTIONS:

- Consult accompanying Safety Data Sheet (SDS).
- Do not use after the expiration date.
- ReminGel is not sterile and is not intended to be sterilized. Failure to follow these instructions could damage the product resulting in procedural delays or user inconvenience.

#### STORAGE:

 Store at room temperature between 18°C (64°F) and 30°C (86°F) in a cool, dry place.

#### WARNINGS:

- Keep out of reach of children.
- For dental use only.
- Always check the expiration date prior to use.
- Do not use if package is damaged.
- Stop use and ask a doctor if:
  - sore mouth symptoms appear and do not improve within seven days,
  - irritation, pain or redness persists or worsens, or
  - swelling, rash, or fever develops.
- ReminGel has not been tested on pregnant or nursing mothers.



#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

(Application using a Dental Appliance such as a Fluoride Tray, Whitening Tray, PerioTray, etc.):

- Cut tube tip close to the narrow end.
- Express a ribbon of ReminGel in the dental appliance tray.
- 3. Insert tray containing ReminGel into the mouth in typical fashion such that the ReminGel contacts the teeth.
- 4. Spit out any excess ReminGel.
- Leave ReminGel in contact with the teeth for 3-15 minutes.
  Recommended contact duration: 15 minutes, unless otherwise directed by your dentist or doctor.
- Remove tray and rinse mouth with water.
   A toothbrush may be helpful to remove any residual ReminGel from the teeth surface.
- 7. Use up to four times daily or as directly by a dentist or doctor.
